Bogue Banks Access

Carteret County, NC – Bogue Banks will begin the re-entry process in some locations starting tomorrow to allow our residents and property owners to assess the condition of their property. Emerald Isle, Indian Beach, Salter Path, and Atlantic Beach will have access to re-entry permit holders Sunday September 16, 2018 at 1 p.m. Pine Knolls Shore residents will be able to re-enter on Monday September 17, 2018 at 1 p.m.

Residents for the unincorporated area of Salter Path may receive re-entry permits from the Carteret County Sheriff's representative Chief Deputy Fulcher at the Emergency Operations Center located at 300 N. 12th St. Morehead City NC 28557 at 9 a.m. September 16, 2018. Salter Path residents must have their photo id and proof of property ownership in order to receive a re-entry pass.

Residents of Emerald Isle, Indian Beach and Salter Path must enter by the Emerald Isle Bridge. Atlantic Beach and Pine Knoll Shores must enter by the Atlantic Beach Bridge.
