**Curfew Lifted**  
September 24, 2018  
5:00 p.m.

Carteret County, NC – Carteret County issued a State of Emergency effective 6:00 p.m., Sunday, September 9, 2018; the declaration ahead of Hurricane Florence in order to more effectively protect the lives and property of the residents in Carteret County.

A modification has been issued effective 10:00 a.m. September 24, 2018 to the following provisions of the County Emergency Ordinance:

The curfew is lifted for all persons who are located within the geographic boundaries of Carteret County.

Without curfew restrictions; there can be sale, consumption, transportation, and possession of alcoholic beverages during the State of Emergency in the County of Carteret.

As well, sale or purchase of any type of firearm or ammunition, or any possession of such items along with any type of explosive off owner's own premises are permitted.

The State of Emergency issued September 9, 2018 continues to be in effect for Carteret County residents. All civilians and emergency management personnel are ordered to continue to comply with the emergency plan.
