**AMENDED PROCLAMATION  
OF THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CARTERET COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
TO THE PROCLAMATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, Carteret County declared a State of Emergency on March 19, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, Carteret County repeals: the earlier discouragement of entry into our County by those who are not residents or property owners of the County, stated in the March 19, 2020 Proclamation, the definitions of essential activities, etc. highlighted in the March 27, 2020 Proclamation and the March 30, 2020 Proclamation that prohibited the rental of a hotel room, motel room, rental housing unit, condominium, RV campsite, primitive campsite, or similar accommodation for less than thirty consecutive days through April 29, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, it is imperative that we begin activating a strategy to restart economies within Carteret County; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that this Amended Proclamation hereby lifts the restrictions placed on travel into our County by those who are not residents or property owners, and also lifts the rental restrictions effective beginning April 30, 2020; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a State of Emergency remains declared within the jurisdiction of Carteret County; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that it continues to be essential in slowing the transmission of COVID-19 to follow the identified guidelines which include in part: maintaining social distance by keeping six feet from each other; consider wearing a mask while out in public; if you feel sick, stay home and contact your medical provider; if you are an older person or a person with underlying health issues, stay home and away from other people; avoid social gatherings in groups of more than ten people; practice good hygiene by frequently washing your hands, avoid touching your face, sneeze or cough into a tissue or the inside of your elbow; and disinfect items and surfaces frequently.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that this Amended Proclamation supersedes all previous Proclamations of a State of Emergency within the County, and hereby lifts any restrictions placed by previous Proclamations.
