## **Carteret County COVID-19 Confirmed COVID-19 Death Reported Press Release #123**

**Carteret County, NC** – The Carteret County Health Department regrets to inform that the County received the report of a confirmed COVID-19 death of a Carteret County resident. The resident was in their 40's, had pre-existing health conditions and died from complications associated with the COVID-19 virus. To protect the privacy of the family, no further information about the resident will be released.

“We were sad to hear of this resident’s passing and we send our condolences to their family and friends,” stated Carteret County Consolidated Human Services Director, Cindy Holman. “I encourage everyone to get the vaccine to protect yourself and help protect your neighbors from contracting this deadly virus.”
